**Washington Women's Bible Study Registration** for "The Case for Christmas" November 2, 2022 and November 9, 2022 from 9:30-11:00am

In this video Bible study, by New York Times bestselling author Lee Strobel, we will dig into the true Christmas story to sort out the fact from the fiction and the hype from the holiness. The Case for Christmas study helps you reflect on the gospel story of the birth of Jesus in a focused, group-oriented way that might change the way you view the season.

During his faith journey, Lee Strobel investigated the real meaning behind all those nativity scenes he saw outside of churches. In this study, Lee reveals what he discovered from consulting experts on the Bible, archaeology, and messianic prophecy as he sought to separate the truth from the tradition.

In each session we will explore:

What the Bible actually says about Jesus' birth and how you can know it's accurate.

Whether the Christmas story actually happened or developed from the myths of the day.

The Bible's claim that Jesus was born of a virgin and why it's important to your faith.

How Jesus--and only Jesus--fulfilled hundreds of Old Testament biblical prophecies about the Messiah.

Regardless of whether the center of your Christmas decorations is the nativity set on your mantle or the presents under the tree, The Case for Christmas study invites you to look beyond the familiar traditions of the season, challenge you to examine the evidence for yourself, and consider why Christmas really matters and why it's still so relevant today.

Each video session is approximately 20 minutes in length. We will watch two videos each week.

The opening lines and chapters of Genesis teach us fundamental truths about God. We watch Him bring light after darkness, order after chaos, and rest after toil—all through the power of His Word.

Over 10 sessions of verse-by-verse study, dive into the first 11 chapters of Genesis by following three critical stages of understanding: comprehension, interpretation, and application. Teaching videos are key in understanding this study. Revisit familiar stories and historical figures, challenge your basic knowledge, and discover deeper meanings in the text. As God reveals Himself through Scripture, we can only begin to understand ourselves when we first glimpse the character, attributes, and promises of our Creator.

Personal study segments with homework to complete between 10 weeks of group sessions  Essential teaching videos that build upon and tie together the personal study  Verse-by-verse study for comprehension, interpretation, and application
